✚Genesis 1:5

Right here in the 5th verse of the Set-apart Scriptures, we see the definition of a 24-hour day. When it says, “Dusk came and dawn came, day one” we understand that the dawn stated here ends THE FIRST DAY of creation. If dawn ends the first day, then the previous dawn BEGAN THE FIRST DAY of creation. You see, dusk and dawn are a point in time made up of a mixture, dusk is a mixture of daylight and darkness. Dawn is a mixture of darkness and daylight. Whenever

you see the word dusk, you know there was approximately a 12-hour period of daylight preceeding the dusk. The same with the word dawn, you know there was approximately a 12-hour period of darkness that preceeded the dawn. These two 12-hour periods of time make up the 24-hour day as we know it. The Hebrew is quite clear here in verse 5; by stating dusk first, we know the first 12 hours of creation happened during the daylight hours of the first day of creation. Then, we see that dawn ended the first day of creation, meaning that if there was any creativity happening in the second 12-hour period of day one, it happened during the darkness of night, ending day one at dawn (which began day two), just as the Scriptures state.

✚Genesis 1:14

The Vernal Equinox is a sign in the heavens and it defines the ending and beginning of our biblical calendar year. Day 1 of our year is the day after the Vernal Equinox. We count 364 biblical days from dawn to dawn, then begin again the day after the next Vernal Equinox. The equinoxes and the solstices close the quarters and add 1 day to the 3rd, 6th, 9th, and 12th months.

✚Genesis 1:16

The word “moon” does not appear in the Torah until Genesis 37:9, approximately 3,758 years into human history, when Joseph was 17 years old!! The moon is only visible at night about 14 nights per lunar cycle. There is no way the moon could be construed as a regulator of the night.

"I AM"... OR "I WILL BE"?

The Hidden Meaning of Yehowah's Name That Most Bibles Never Explain

For generations, millions have read Exodus 3:14 like this:

"I AM THAT I AM."

But what if that translation only scratches the surface?

What if Yehowah wasn't simply declaring that He exists...

What if He was revealing how He works?

The Hebrew says:

אֶהְיֶה אֲשֶׁר אֶהְיֶה

Ehyeh Asher Ehyeh

Most English Bibles render it:

"I AM THAT I AM."

But the Hebrew verb Ehyeh comes from hayah, meaning:

To be

To become

To exist

To happen

To come to pass

Here's where it gets fascinating.

The word Ehyeh is not a simple present-tense verb. It is in the imperfect form—a Hebrew verb form that often describes ongoing or future action.

So it can also mean:

"I WILL BE."

That changes everything.

Instead of saying:

"I AM THAT I AM."

Yehowah could just as accurately be saying:

"I WILL BE WHO I WILL BE."

Or even:

"I WILL PROVE TO BE WHATEVER I CHOOSE TO BE."

Think about the context.

Moses asks:

"What is Your Name?"

Yehowah doesn't hand Moses a dictionary definition.

He reveals His character.

Almost immediately before this, He tells Moses:

"Certainly I WILL BE with you." (Exodus 3:12)

The exact same Hebrew word appears:

Ehyeh.

Then two verses later He says:

"Ehyeh Asher Ehyeh."

This isn't a coincidence.

The message is not merely:

"I exist."

The message is:

"I WILL BE WITH YOU."

"I will be everything My people need Me to be."

When Israel needs a Deliverer...

He will be there.

When they need a Shepherd...

He will be there.

When they need a Judge...

He will be there.

When they need Healing...

He will be there.

When they need Mercy...

He will be there.

When they need Justice...

He will be there.

Yehowah is not limited to one title or one function.

Unlike the pagan deities of the nations—each assigned a narrow role—Yehowah declares that no human title can contain Him.

He is the Eternal One who faithfully reveals Himself throughout history according to His covenant purposes.

Then comes another amazing detail.

Immediately after saying Ehyeh Asher Ehyeh, He tells Moses:

"Say to the children of Israel, 'Ehyeh has sent me to you.'"

And in the very next verse He declares:

"YHWH... this is My Name forever."

Many Hebrew scholars understand Ehyeh ("I will be") and YHWH to be closely connected through the Hebrew root hayah ("to be"). While the exact derivation is debated, the relationship points to the same truth:

The One speaking says, "I will be."

His people speak of Him as:

"He is."

His Name is not just about existence.

It is about faithfulness.

It is about presence.

It is about keeping covenant.

Every generation discovers another aspect of who He is, yet He never changes.

Perhaps the greatest revelation hidden in Exodus 3 is this:

Yehowah did not simply tell Moses His Name.

He gave Israel a promise.

"I WILL BE."

Not just yesterday.

Not just today.

But tomorrow.

Forever.

Maybe the greatest meaning of "Ehyeh Asher Ehyeh" isn't "I AM"...

It's "I WILL BE THERE."

And if He could be there for Moses...

He can still be there for you.

The Didache – Point 9

9 Concerning the Last Supper Commemoration

9:1 Concerning the Last Supper commemoration, give thanks this way.

**9:2 First, concerning the cup: We thank you, our Father, for the set-
apart vine of David your servant, which you made known to us
through Yeshua your servant. To you be the glory forever.**

**9:3 Next, concerning the broken bread: We thank you, our Father, for
the life and knowledge which you made known to us through Yeshua
your servant. To you be the glory forever.**

**9:4 Even as this broken bread was scattered over the hills, and was
gathered together and became oneness, so let your congregation be
gathered together from the ends of the earth into your kingdom. To
you is the glory and the power through Yeshua Messiah forever.**

9:5 Allow no one to eat or drink of your Last Supper commemoration, unless they have been immersed in the name of the Lord. For concerning this, the Lord has said, "Do not give what is set apart to dogs."

((Judaism preserves an ancient after-meals prayer of thanksgiving that is still recited today. The four blessings of the traditional Grace after Meals can be found in any Jewish prayer book. The oldest version of Grace after Meals is preserved in the Didache. This early, Apostolic-age Grace after Meals was composed by early believers. They recited it together after ceremonial community meals conducted in remembrance of Yeshua to fulfill the commandment of Deuteronomy 8:10. Like the traditional Jewish version of Grace after Meals, it consists of four blessings thanking Yehowah for provision and looking forward to the Messianic Era:

We thank You, our holy Father, for Your holy name that You have caused to dwell in our hearts, and for the knowledge, faithfulness, and eternal life that You have made known to us through Your servant Yeshua. Yours is the glory forever. (Amen)

You, O Mighty One of Legions, created all things for the sake of Your name; You gave nourishment and drink for human beings to enjoy, in order that they would give thanks to You. The Complete Text

1 There Are Two Ways

1:1 There are two ways, one of life and one of death! And there is a great difference between the two ways.

1:2 The Way of life is this: First, you shall love Yehowah who made you. And second, love your neighbor as yourself, and do not do to another what you would not want done to you.

1:3 The meaning of these sayings is this: Bless those who curse you, and pray for your enemies, and fast for those who persecute you. For what reward is there for loving those who love you? Do not the heathens do the same? But you should love those who hate you, and then you shall have no enemies.

1:4 Abstain from fleshly and bodily lusts: If someone strikes your right cheek, turn the other also, and be perfect. If someone forces you to go one kilometer, go two. If someone takes your cloak, give also your coat. If someone takes from you what is yours, don't ask for it back. You really cannot.

1:5 Give to every one who asks you, and don't ask for it back. The Father wants his blessings shared. Happy is the giver who lives according to this rule, for that one is guiltless. But the receiver must beware; for if one receives who has need, he is guiltless, but if one receives not having need, he shall stand trial, answering why he received and for what use. If he is found guilty he shall not escape until he pays back the last penny.

1:6 However, concerning this, there is a saying: "Let your alms sweat in your hands until you know to whom to give them."

2 The Second Commandment

2:1 The second commandment of the teaching is this:

2:2 Do not commit murder; do not commit adultery; do not corrupt

boys; do not have illicit sex; do not steal; do not practice magic; do not practice witchcraft; you shall not murder a child, whether it be born or unborn (abortion). Do not covet the things of your neighbor.

2:3 Do not swear or bear false witness. Do not speak evil of others; do not bear grudges.

2:4 You should not be double-minded or double-tongued, for a double-tongue is a deadly snare.

2:5 Your speech should not be false nor empty, but fulfilled by action.

2:6 Do not be covetous, or greedy, or hypocritical, or malicious, or arrogant. Do not have designs against your neighbor.

2:7 Hate no one; correct some, pray for others, and some you should love more than your own life.

3 My Child, Flee Evil

3:1 My child, flee evil of all kinds, and everything like it.

3:2 Don't be prone to anger, for anger leads to murder. Don't be jealous or quarrelsome or hot-tempered, for all these things lead to murder.

3:3 My child, don't be lustful, for lust leads to illicit sex. Don't be a filthy talker or allow your eyes a free reign, for these lead to adultery.

3:4 My child, don't observe omens, since it leads to idolatry. Don't be an enchanter, or an astrologer, or a purifier, or be willing to see or hear about these things, for these all lead to idolatry.

3:5 My child, don't be a liar, since a lie leads to theft. Don't love money or seek glory, for these things lead to thievery.

3:6 My child, don't grumble, since it leads to blasphemy, and don't be

self-willed or evil-minded, for all these things lead to blasphemy.

3:7 On the contrary, be gentle, since the gentle will inherit the earth.

3:8 Be long-suffering and pitiful and guileless and gentle and good, and with trembling, treasure the words you have received.

3:9 Don't exalt yourself or open your heart to overconfidence. Don't be on intimate terms with mighty people, but with just and lowly ones.

3:10 Accept whatever happens to you as a blessing, knowing that nothing comes to pass apart from Yehowah.

4 My Child, Remember

[4:1 My child, remember day and night him who speaks the word of Yehowah to you, and honor him as the Lord. For wherever his lordship is spoken of, there he is.]

4:2 Seek each day the faces of the saints, in order that you may be refreshed by their words.

4:3 Do not initiate divisions, but rather bring shalom to those who contend against one another. Judge righteously, and do not take social status into account when reproofing for transgressions.

4:4 Do not waver in your decisions.

4:5 Do not be one who opens his hands to receive, or closes them when it is time to give.

4:6 If you have anything, by your hands you should give ransom for your sins.

4:7 Do not hesitate to give, and do not complain about it. You will know in time who is the good Rewarder.

4:8 Do not turn away from one who is in want; rather, share all things with your brother, and do not say that they are your own. For if you are sharers in what is imperishable, how much more in things which perish!

4:9 Do not remove your hand from your son or daughter; teach them the fear of Yehowah from their youth.

4:10 Do not give orders to your servants when you are angry, for they hope in the same Almighty, and they may lose the fear of Yehowah, who is over both of you. Yehowah is surely not coming to call on us according to our outward appearance or station in life, but to them whom the Ruach has prepared.

4:11 And you, servants, be subject to your masters as to Yehowah's image, in modesty and fear.

4:12 You should hate all hypocrisy and everything which is not pleasing to the Lord.

4:13 Do not in any way neglect the commandments of the Lord, but keep what you have received, neither adding nor taking away anything.

4:14 In your gatherings, confess your transgressions, and do not come for prayer with a guilty conscience.

This is the Way of life!

5 The Way of Death

5:1 The way of death, on the other hand, is this: It is evil and accursed—murders, adulteries, lust, illicit sex, thefts, idolatries, magical arts, sorceries, robberies, false testimonies, hypocrisy, double-heartedness, deceit, haughtiness, depravity, self-will, greediness, filthy talking, jealousy, over-confidence, loftiness, boastfulness—those who do not fear Yehowah.

5:2 The way of death is the way of those who persecute the good, hate the truth, love lies, and do not understand the reward for righteousness. They do not cleave to good or righteous judgment; they do not watch for what is good, but for what is evil. They are strangers to meekness and patience, loving vanities, pursuing revenge, without pity for the needy and oppressed. They do not know their Creator; they are murderers of children (includes abortion), destroyers of Yehowah's image. They turn away from those who are in need, making matters worse for those who are distressed. They are advocates for the rich, unjust judges of the poor. In a word, the way of death is full of those who are steeped in sin. Be delivered, children, from all of this!

6 See That No One Leads You Astray

6:1 See that no one leads you astray from the Way of this teaching, since all other teachings train you without Yehowah.

6:2 For if you are able to bear the entire yoke of the Lord, you will be perfect; but if you are not able, then at least do what you can.

6:3 Concerning food, do what you are able to do and be on guard against meat offered to idols, for that is to worship dead deities.

7 Concerning Immersion

7:1 Concerning immersion, you should immerse this way: After first explaining all things, immerse in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of Ruach Ha'Kodesh, in flowing water.

7:2 But if you have no running water, immerse in other water; and if you cannot do so in cold water, then in warm.

7:3 If you have very little, pour water three times on the head in the name of the Father and the Son and Ruach Kodesh.

7:4 Before the immersion, both the immerser and the candidate for immersion, plus any others who can, should fast. The candidate should fast for one or two days beforehand.

8 Your Fasts and Prayers

8:1 Your fasts should not be with the hypocrites, for they fast on Mondays and Thursdays. You should fast on Wednesdays and Fridays.

8:2 And do not pray like the hypocrites, but rather as the Lord commanded in the gospel: Our Father in heaven, set apart be your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us enough bread day-by-day. And forgive us our sin debts, as we also have forgiven those who sin against us. And do not bring us to the time of trial, but rescue us from the evil one.

8:3 Pray this three times each day.

9 Concerning the Last Supper Commemoration

9:1 Concerning the Last Supper commemoration, give thanks this way.

9:2 First, concerning the cup: We thank you, our Father, for the set-apart vine of David your servant, which you made known to us through Yeshua your servant. To you be the glory forever.

9:3 Next, concerning the broken bread: We thank you, our Father, for the life and knowledge which you made known to us through Yeshua your servant. To you be the glory forever.

9:4 Even as this broken bread was scattered over the hills, and was gathered together and became oneness, so let your congregation be gathered together from the ends of the earth into your kingdom. To you is the glory and the power through Yeshua Messiah forever.

9:5 Allow no one to eat or drink of your Last Supper commemoration, unless they have been immersed in the name of the Lord. For

concerning this, the Lord has said, "Do not give what is set apart to dogs."

10 After the Last Supper commemoration

10:1 After the Last Supper commemoration when you are filled, give thanks this way:

10:2 We thank you, set-apart Father, for your set-apart name which you enshrined in our hearts, and for the knowledge and faith and immortality that you made known to us through Yeshua your servant. To you be the glory forever.

10:3 You, Master Yehowah, have created all things for your name's sake. You gave food and drink to all people for enjoyment, that they might give thanks to you; but to us you freely give spiritual food and drink and life eternal through Yeshua, your servant.

10:4 Before all things we thank you because you are mighty. To you be the glory forever.

10:5 Remember, Lord, your congregation. Deliver it from all evil and make it perfect in your love, and gather it from the four winds sanctified for your kingdom which you have prepared for it. For Yours is the power and the glory forever.

10:6 Let grace come, and let this world pass away!

Hosanna to the Son of David! If anyone is set apart, let him come; if anyone is not set apart, let him repent. Maranatha! Amen.

[10:7 But permit the prophets to make thanksgiving as much as they desire.]

11 Welcome the Teacher

11:1 Welcome the teacher when he comes to instruct you in all that has

been said.

11:2 But if he turns and trains you in another tradition to the destruction of this teaching, do not listen. If he teaches so as to increase righteousness and the knowledge of the Lord, receive him as the Lord.

11:3 Act according to the precepts of the gospel concerning all apostles and prophets:

11:4 Let every apostle who comes to you be received as the Lord.

11:5 But he must not remain more than one day, or two, if there's a need. If he stays three days, he is a false prophet.

11:6 And when the apostle goes away, let him take nothing but bread to last him until his next night of lodging. If he asks for money, he is a false prophet.

11:7 In addition, if any prophet speaks in the Ruach, you shall not try or judge him; for every sin will be forgiven, but this sin cannot be forgiven.

11:8 But not everyone who speaks in the Ruach is a prophet; only he is a prophet who has the Ways of the Lord about him. By their ways will the false prophet and the prophet be known.

11:9 Any prophet who orders a meal in the Ruach does not eat it; if he does, he is indeed a false prophet.

11:10 And any prophet who teaches the truth, but does not do what he teaches, is a false prophet.

11:11 When a prophet, proved true, works for the mystery of the congregation in the world but does not teach others to do what he himself does, he will not be judged among you, for his judgment is already before Yehowah. The ancient prophets acted in this Way, also.

11:12 But whoever says in the Ruach, "Give me money," or something else like this, you must not listen to him. But if he tells you to give for the sake of others who are in need, let no one judge him.

12 Welcome Anyone Coming in the Name of the Lord

12:1 Welcome anyone coming in the name of the Lord. Receive everyone who comes in the name of the Lord, but then, test them and use your discretion.

12:2 If he who comes is a transient, assist him as far as you are able; but he should not remain with you more than two or three days, if need be.

12:3 If he wants to stay with you, and is a craftsman, let him work for his living.

12:4 But if he has no trade, use your judgment in providing for him; for a Messianic should not live idle in your midst.

12:5 If he is dissatisfied with this sort of an arrangement, he is a Messiah peddler. Watch that you keep away from such people.

13 Every Genuine prophet

13:1 Every genuine prophet who wants to live among you is worthy of support.

13:2 So also, every true teacher is, like a workman, entitled to his support.

13:3 Every first fruit, therefore, of the products of vintage and harvest, of cattle and of sheep, should be given as first fruits to the prophets, for they are your high priests.

13:4 But if you have no prophet, give it all to the poor.

13:5 If you bake bread, take the first loaf and give it according to the commandment.

13:6 If you open a new jar of wine or of oil, take the first fruit and give it to the prophets.

13:7 If you acquire money or cloth or any other possession, set aside a portion first, as it may seem good to you, and give according to the commandment.

14 On the Sabbath Day

14:1 On the Sabbath day, gather yourselves together and break bread, give thanks, but first confess your sins so that your sacrifice may be pure.

14:2 However, let no one who is at odds with his brother come together with you, until he has reconciled, so that your sacrifice may not be profaned.

14:3 For this is what the Lord has said: "For from the rising of the sun to its setting my name is great among the ethnicities, and in every place incense is offered to my name, and a pure offering; for my name is great among the ethnicities, says the Mighty One of the heavenly armed forces. . . . For I am a great King, says the Lord of the heavenly armed forces, and my name is revered among the ethnicities."

15 Appoint Elders for Yourselves

15:1 Appoint elders for yourselves, as well as deacons, worthy of the Lord, of meek disposition, unattached to money, truthful and proven; for they also render to you the service of prophets and teachers.

15:2 Do not despise them, after all, for they are your honored ones, together with the prophets and teachers.

15:3 And reprove one another, not in anger, but in shalom, as you have it in the gospel. But to anyone who acts amiss against another, let no one speak to him, nor let him hear anything from you until he repents. But your prayers and alms and all your deeds so do, as you have it in the gospel of our Lord.

16 Watch Over Your Life

16:1 Watch over your life, that your lamps are never quenched, and that your loins are never unloosed. Be ready, for you do not know on what day your Lord is coming.

16:2 Come together often, seeking the things that are good for your souls. A life of faith will not profit you if you are not made perfect at the end of time.

16:3 For in the last days false prophets and corrupters will be plenty, and the sheep will be turned into wolves, and love will be turned into hate.

16:4 When lawlessness increases, they will hate and persecute and betray one another, and then the world-deceiver will appear claiming to be the Son of Yehowah, and he will do signs and wonders, and the earth will be delivered into his hands, and he will do iniquitous things that have not been seen since the beginning of the world.

16:5 Then humankind will enter into the fire of trial, and many will be made to stumble and many will perish; but those who endure in their faith will be saved from under the curse itself.

16:6 And then the signs of the truth will appear: the first sign, an opening of the heavens; the second sign, the sounding of the trumpet; and the third sign, the resurrection of the dead—

16:7 not of every one, but as it is said: "Then the Lord my Divine One will come, and all the set-apart ones with him."

16:8 Finally, "Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in the heavens, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of the virgin coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory."

It was against the Law of Yehowah to fill these jars back up with plain water, until the cleansing water red heifer ashes mixture was completely used up, unless commanded by the High Priest, which Yeshua is! Chanut was the marketplace of the Royal Stoa, a colonnaded structure in the southern Court of the Gentiles.

Dedication is the Hebrew word Chanukkah, Strong's # H2598, used 7 times in the First Covenant. Read all of 1st and 2nd Maccabees to read the story of the Maccabee family warriors who whipped the entire Greek military and rededicated the altar of the 2nd Temple for 8 days in 164 BC, because they had just missed celebrating the Festival of Tabernacles by a couple months. Yeshua celebrated the Festival of Hanukkah, or Dedication, each year of his earthly life. See Josephus Ant. 12.5-13.7; Wars 1.3-6.

✚ John 10:34

Yeshua answered them by quoting from Psalm 82:6-7 with an understood alternative rabbinic interpretation about Mt. Sinai and the Golden Calf incident. Meaning, if the Israelites would not have sinned with the Golden Calf, they would have been like deities and lived forever.

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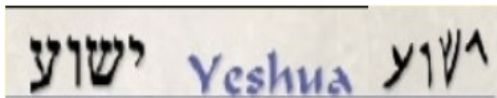

The languages of humans that Paul is speaking about are the 70 languages of the ethnicities that resulted at the Tower of Babel and also Jews believe were heard from the mouth of Yehowah at Mt. Sinai. The language of angels is believed to be the Hebrew language.

This verse is specifically speaking to the ritual tradition of Jews and early Messianics who washed the bodies of dead brethren and sistren. They immersed in mikvah before washing a dead body and after washing a dead body. See Acts 9:37. Also:

WORKS OF THE LAW

This phrase appears nine times in the writings of Shaul/Paul in the New Testament, especially in Galatians.

It does not refer to obedience to the Law of Moses.

The ancient Dead Sea Scrolls found in the Qumran caves between 1946-1956 confirm that this phrase was used for centuries before Shaul. It refers to strict precepts based on twenty-four extra-biblical purity regulations prepared by a religious sect called the Essenes. Galatians is not telling us that Yehowah's law is done away with. It is telling us that man's law is done away with. Salvation is by faith alone.

✚Galatians 3:28

Paired off in marriage and procreation. See Gen. 1:27-28.

✚Galatians 4:26

Jerusalem is due north of Mount Sinai, on the same geographical meridian, at 35° 14' east longitude. Paul had a little wordplay going on in verses 25-26.

✚Galatians 4:31

The free woman referring to being born from above, the New Jerusalem; John 3:3ff.

✚Ephesians 2:10

The word "them" at the end of verse 10 refers directly to the approximately 735 commandments in the Tanak, or First Covenant,

that Yehowah intends for us to obey. By obeying these commandments, we perform many good deeds throughout our life.

✚Colossians 1:2

Colossae was near what is modern Honaz, Turkey.

✚2 Thessalonians 2:3

The falling away may quite possibly be the third abomination of desolation, since the congregation of Messiah is his temple now, housing the Ruach of the Almighty in human flesh. So-called believers removing Yeshua from the throne of their hearts and placing themselves onto the throne of their own hearts is an abomination of desolation. The body of Messiah is thus desolated in the last days.

✚2 Thessalonians 2:7

Dragon may be the one who restrains.

✚2 Timothy 3:8

Ancient literature reveals that Jannes and Jambres were the sons of Balaam and were Pharaoh's pharmacists.

✚2 Timothy 3:13

Wizards are similar to witches and warlocks.

✚2 Timothy 3:16

The Scripture Paul is referring to when writing this letter to Timothy is the Tanach; the Tanach, or First Covenant, was the only written word of Yehowah that 1st century Messianics had for Bible study and reading. It was a few centuries before the New Covenant was pulled together and added to the Canon of Scripture. The 27 books of the New Covenant were canonized in the council of Hippo in 393 AD. This canonization was later affirmed in the council of Carthage in 397 and 419 AD. So, in Paul's eyes, the Tanach was good for discipling new

Messianic believers. Meditate on that for awhile.

The first practice was the Levitical sacrificial system, the second practice is the Melchizedek Priesthood, which actually existed before the so-called first practice.

"Being therefore this kind of person [i.e., a heartless Sadducee], Ananus, thinking that he had a favorable opportunity because Festus had died and Albinus was still on his way, called a meeting [literally, "sanhedrin"] of judges and brought into it the brother of Jesus-who-is-called-Messiah ... James [Jacob] by name, and some others. He made the accusation that they had transgressed the law, and he handed them over to be stoned." Josephus Ant. 20.9.1

✚2 Peter 1:18

Some believe the high set-apart mountain is Mount Hermon, some believe it is Mount Sinai (Mount Yehowah; Horeb).

✚2 Peter 2:5

Noah became the 8th herald of righteousness, because Noah's Greatgrandpa Enoch was taken very early by Yehowah and Lamech, Noah's Dad, died before his Dad, Methuselah, died in the year of the Flood, when Noah was 600 years old, c. 3398 BC. So, Methuselah made Noah the 8th Melchizedek before he died in that year.

1260 days is $1,260 / 360 = 3.5$ years.

One year, two years, and half a year is $360 + 720 + 180 = 1,260$ days.

Forty-two months is $42 \times 30 = 1,260$ days.

An alternate interpretation is that in the handwritten manuscript containing this verse we see the Islamic crossed swords with the Arabic bismillah, "in the name of Allah". See pages 166-168 of Abraham Ojeda's ebook titled, "Bible Prophecy Secrets – Expanded Edition".

This is probably referring to the Plain of Megiddo, below Mt. Carmel.
